HEALTH SCREENINGS

Mandatory MA state health screening for 7th and 10th graders will take place over the next few months in the nurse's office. The testing is performed by the school nurse and includes vision, hearing and scoliosis screening. If your student falls outside the state set parameters of these screenings you will be notified and encouraged to seek follow up with your child's physician.

Height, weight and BMI calculations will also be taking place for 7th and 10th graders. This information will be kept in your child's confidential school health record and available to you upon request.

The Cohasset Skippers are always grateful for community support and hope that you can help us with one more big undertaking before we beat Hull on Thanksgiving Day!

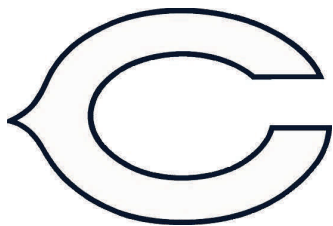
Cohasset Connects...
