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Extended School Year (ESY) 2022

ESY procedure

At least annually, each student's Team must consider the need for extended school year and record its determination in the IEP. A Team's determination regarding the need for an ESY program must be made on an individual basis. ESY in Massachusetts, based on federal law, is designed to provide a free and appropriate public education to children with disabilities who would experience **substantial regression** because of interruption in their instructional program.

Student's liaisons must complete a *Consideration for Extended School Year* application form and submit this application for each student requiring ESY to the Team Chair for their building. Each liaison addresses the questions on the ESY form and collects data that details "substantial regression." Most of this information is gathered during the month of March; some cases do require data collection following the April break. This is a necessary timeline in order to provide for planning, staffing, and implementing a quality ESY program.

Please note, that just because a student has received ESY services in the past, this fact alone will not qualify the student to receive ESY services in the future. The need for ESY and meeting "substantial regression" criteria must be examined yearly.
