If you'd like to practice math skills over the summer, here are some ideas.

Practice addition and subtractions facts to 10.

Have your child explain the strategies they use.

Count by tens from any number.

14, 24, 34...

65, 55, 45...

Try adding and subtracting multiples of ten to and from 2 digit numbers.

$$56 + 10 =$$

$$75 - 10 =$$

$$33 + 20 =$$

$$98 - 20 =$$

Tell Time

Count Change

Estimate quantity, time, and distance.

The best thing you can do over the summer is to **play games**.

Board games and card games both foster mental math.
