Getting Started



How is logging into a Google account different from logging into Chrome browser?

Google – users can log into a <u>Google Account</u> from any device or browser with internet access. This allows you to access your <u>Google Drive</u>, Google apps like Classroom, Docs, Sheets, and Slides









Chrome Browser



Chrome Browser - Allows the user to log into the *browser* which contains & syncs your browsing history, bookmarks, apps & extensions, along with your Google Account & files.

For school Google this means logging into the Chrome browser will sync extensions & apps made available by the school.




