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2023 Sixth Grade Summer Reading Activity Sheet

CHOOSE ONE OF THE ACTIVITIES BELOW

For **one** of the books you read, please complete **one** of the activities below. You will need to hand this in during the first week of school.

1. Letter: Write a letter to the main character in your book offering advice on how they could overcome an obstacle or problem they faced in the story.

2. Comic Strip: Make a comic strip of the most important events in your book. Be sure to include speech bubbles and dialogue!

3. Playlist: Create a playlist of at least five songs that relate to the characters, setting, conflict, plot and/or theme of the book. Include the song title, artist, and a brief explanation about how each song relates to the book. Each explanation should be 2-3 sentences per song.

4. Switch: Rewrite a significant event from the perspective of another character (other than the main character). What would they have seen? What would they have felt? What would they have thought?

5. Advertisement Poster: Create a poster to advertise your book. This poster should be visually appealing and should include intriguing details that would inspire viewers to read the book. Your poster should include a 5-6 sentence summary of the book for potential readers to explore.
