For one of the books you read, please complete one of the activities below. You will need to hand this in during the first week of school.

- 1. Letter:** Write a letter to the main character in your book offering advice on how he or she could overcome an obstacle or problem he or she faced in the story.
- 2. Comic Strip:** Make a comic strip of the most important event in your book.
- 3. Text Messages:** Create a list of 12 make-believe text messages the main character in your book could have sent to another character over the course of the story.
- 4. Illustration for Graphic Novel:** Pretend you have been asked to illustrate a page of the graphic novel adaptation of your book. Draw the picture(s) that would appear on that page.
- 5. Poem:** Write a poem to capture the feelings of the main character of your book.
- 6. Google Search:** Write a Google search history for your main character listing 8-10 topics he or she may have searched over the course of the novel.
