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## Cohasset Public Schools Expectations for Safety and Privacy during Remote Learning

The following letter was sent out to families earlier this week explaining our expectations regarding safety and privacy during the Remote Learning period. In addition, a link to this letter has been placed on the signature line of all emails.

Currently, school administrators and educators are working together to finalize remote learning plans. These plans will include one or more of the following, pending approval by the school board, the superintendent, and the state board of education. Because we expect at least some of the remote learning to be conducted via virtual, telephonic, or other means, the Cohasset Public Schools expect the school community to be responsible for ensuring the participants' privacy and of maintaining a safe, respectful environment conducive to learning. Thus, the school district expects of participants (including but not limited to students, teachers, parents, guardians, and other staff) to adhere to the following expectations in virtual, telephonic, or other or electronic sessions (collectively referred to as "remote sessions," regardless of technology used):

- Participants will not share the link to the remote sessions with others or otherwise invite or allow others to participate in the remote sessions, without the school district's express consent.
- Participants agree to participate in remote sessions in a quiet, private area free of distractions, to the extent possible, to provide an environment conducive to learning and to protect the students' and other participants' privacy.
- To the extent virtual technologies are used, participants acknowledge other participants in the remote sessions will see whatever is visible by the participants' webcam or other device, including but not limited to themselves, their children, and portions of their homes. Likewise, participants acknowledge that they will see whatever is broadcasted by other participants. Accordingly, participants are encouraged to participate in remote sessions in appropriate locations and to refrain from activities that would cause such

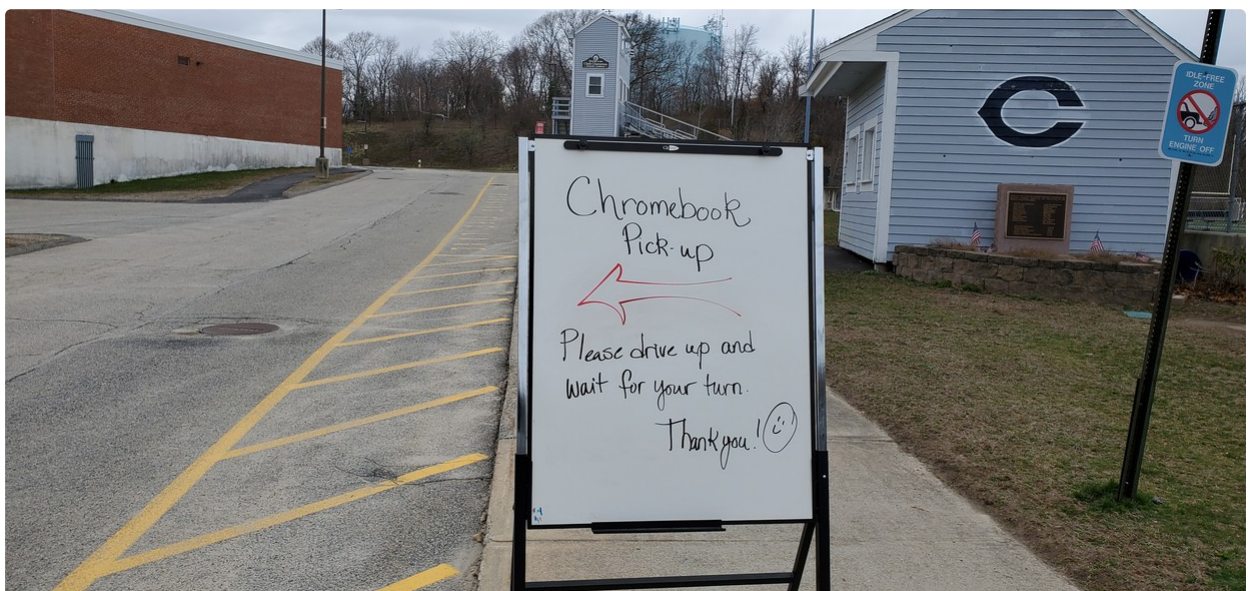


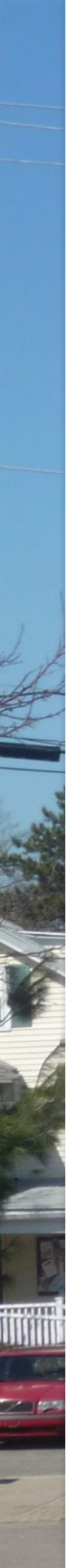
