

Greetings Cohasset Families,

Here is an update regarding the status of school events, activities and facility use as of March 12, 2020. The following events have been cancelled:

- The March 17 & March 18 All School Concerts
- The March 23 Spring Sports Night
- The March 25 and March 26 Parent-Teacher Conferences at Osgood and Deer Hill (stay tuned for possible alternatives to face-to-face conferences)

The following activities have been suspended until March 30. Information will be sent out on March 27 or when more information is available:

- All after school activities...this includes Spring Sports and all events after school in all of our schools. As of now, per. Order of the MIAA first day of practice for Spring Sports is Monday, March 30.

As of Friday, March 13, all agreements that were in place for any outside group, individual or organization to use any of our school buildings are cancelled. These restrictions will be reviewed on March 27.

In an effort to limit the amount of people entering our schools, we are not allowing presenters, trainers and volunteers in our classes until further notice. Special Education Team Meetings will be conducted via Teleconference if parents would not like to reschedule due to timelines. We will be exploring ways to hold meetings via telephone or video conference when possible. Until further notice, we will be cancelling most events that bring people other than our students and staff into the buildings.

We are adjusting our Professional Development Day on Friday, March 20 to allow for thorough cleaning to take place in all of our buildings. Faculty will participate remotely with the Professional Development on March 20. As was previously scheduled there is no school on March 20. March 19 is a scheduled half-day. Faculty will engage in their normally scheduled Professional Development after the students leave the buildings on March 19.
