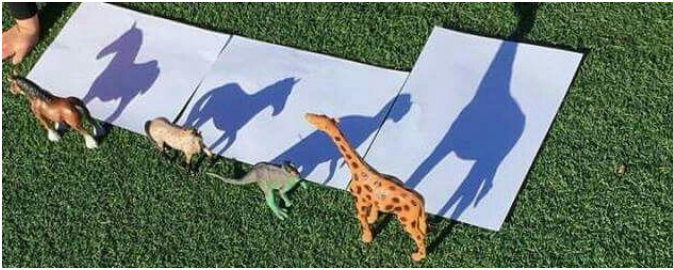


Art and Science

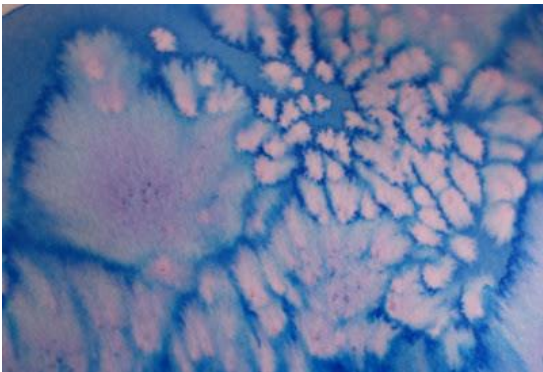
- **Use the sun, to create shadow drawings of you or objects**

Take this project outside! All you need is paper, pencil and some objects. Could always try with chalk and use your or a sibling's shadow!



- **Salt and water color painting**

Salt absorbs water! So use salt in places where you may have puddles of water. When all dry remember to rub salt off.



- **Pick some leaves to draw using the Chlorophyll**

Yes the green color will come off on the paper! So get some leaves ball them up and start coloring!



- **Oil and water droplet painting**

This one needs more materials but really cool effect. I like to use food die and water mix. Place this mixture in the bottom of a shallows baking dish. Pour $\frac{1}{4}$ cup oil in a small bowl. Use a pipette OR paint brush to place small drops of oil on to the water color. Once enough drops of oil place paper on top.



- **Use leaves or some grass to create some nature rubbings**

My favorite, who doesn't love some nature art. Take leaf, place it under the paper. You will need a peeled crayon and rub! Another trick try with a white crayon and then water color paint over so it appears!



- **Have some CDs, water and a flashlight to create some rainbows**

Have any old CDs and want to explore rainbows? You are in luck. All you need is a small bowl of water, a CD, piece of paper, coloring materials and a window (if sunlight is not bright enough use a flash light). You may have to play with the positioning of the CD a little to get the rainbow onto the paper.
